

CENTER TOWNSHIP, CROW WING COUNTY
MONTHLY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING
JUNE 10, 2014

The monthly meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm and pledge led by chairman Ranweiler.; also in attendance were Supervisors Linda McCabe & Leon Yeager; Gail Lunde treasurer & Coralea Borden, clerk. Motion Yeager to approve minutes of May 12, 2014 meeting; McCabe seconds; all aye; motion carried.

Constituent concerns

Jim Converse in attendance & was wondering if there are still funds available to make improvements to Acorn Ridge. Board would like to see more approval from the property owners before any research is done regarding subject.

Old Business:

All three supervisors attended Fire meeting last month at Mission town hall. Yeager feels that the coverage we are currently paying for is reasonable. The meeting will be continued on June 30th at 7:00pm at Mission town hall. Board will continue to work on contracts for 2015-2017.

Ranweiler received bid to close pump at old hall from Justins Well service. Bid came in at \$275.00 plus permit fee. McCabe makes motion to abandon well; Yeager seconds: all aye; motion carried.

Ranweiler has talked to property owner of new home being built on Green Forest Circle. Explained to owners that a culvert is needed in drive. A one foot steal culvert is required. Ranweiler also requested that they fixed ruts that were left from trucks hauling building materials.

Town/Fire Hall Update:

Bruce Lunde reports that there are several items left out at cemetery that are hard to mow & trim around. Board feels that items left at grave sites for longer than 2 weeks should be removed. A sign is to be placed at each entrance of cemetery stating that any items that cannot be trimmed or mowed around will be removed.

Crow Wing Power has checked out the heating system at the hall & did not find any problems. He explained that the meter for the watershed has not turned since early March. Bruce to call Horizon heating & plumbing to schedule an appointment & have them check into system further.

Road Report:

Ranweiler has gotten bid for class 5 delivered at 14.00 per yd from Anderson Brothers. Bid was also received from Borden Excavating on several roads- 650 yards class 5 Borden rd \$12,600, shaping, additional ditching. Creek road- approx 500 yards class 5 needed \$10,000, Gallus rd. approx 300 yards class 5, widening road \$ 6700.00, Old Mill from Co rd 116 South to Borden 1300 yards class 5 \$24,200. Ossipee 750 yards \$14,000, Antler \$4800.00. Class 5 & labor for all roads is \$72,300. Tri city has a dust control contract with city of Brainerd & they charge .91 per gallon. Cost is approx \$2562.50 per mile. McCabe makes motion to approve work as specified for graveling of above roads; Ranweiler seconds; all aye; motion carried. McCabe makes motion to apply dust control to approx 2.75 miles of road which would include Silver Lake Road, Borden Road, Old Mill S, Ossipee; Yeager seconds; all aye; motion carried.

New Business:

Ranweiler makes motion to reschedule August monthly meeting due to August primary election to Monday, August 11 at 7:00 pm; McCabe seconds; all aye; motion carried.

McCabe makes motion to approve election judges as on file with clerk; Yeager seconds all aye; motion carried..

Planning & zoning:

One new permit for new construction was issued in township in the last month.

Treasurers Report/ Check Approval

McCabe makes motion to approve check numbers 11366- 11381 in the amount of \$8435.07. Ranweiler seconds; all aye; motion carried. McCabe makes motion to approve treasurer report; Ranweiler seconds; all aye; motion carried. Yeager moves to adjourn; McCabe seconds; meeting adjourned at 8:25pm.
