

CENTER TOWNSHIP, CROW WING COUNTY  
ANNUAL TOWN MEETING, MARCH 9, 2021, 8:15 PM

The annual meeting was called to order at 8:15 pm by clerk, Coralea Borden. Pledge was led.

Linda McCabe; I nominate Tom Borden as moderator. Erik Lunemann; I second; unanimous aye.

Minutes of 2020 annual meeting were distributed. Moderator asks for any corrections to be made to 2020 minutes; none. Minutes stand approved.

**General Report:** McCabe reports that township has been pretty quiet for this last year. Improvements were made to water shed building and looks good.

**Road Report:** Yeager reports that road tour did not take place in 2020 due to covid restrictions. Dust control was placed on several roads and board was happy with the outcome.

**Cemetery:** McCabe reports that cemetery has been in good shape with Jay taking great care maintaining it.

**Fire Report:** No one present from Fire Dept for this annual meeting.

2020 Financial reports were distributed; Tom Borden asked if everyone had a chance to look over the reports. McCabe; I make motion to approve 2020 reports; Lunemann; I second; all aye; motion carried.

Linda McCabe reports that board is anticipating future repair of paved roads & is requesting increase in road fund for the 2022 levy. Proposed increase from \$150,000 to \$175,000. Also increase to bond repayment fund from \$20,000 to \$25,000 due to decrease in bond sellers credit. 2022 proposed levy has increase from \$285,000 to \$315,000. Fire fund to remain same at \$55,000 ; General to remain at \$60,000 & cemetery at zero. Erik Lunemann; I make motion to approve 2022 proposed levy; Linda McCabe; I second; all aye; motion carried.

Linda McCabe; I make motion to set 2022 Annual meeting for Tuesday March 18, 2022 at 8:15pm; Melonie Flaws; I second; all aye; motion carried.

Linda McCabe; I make motion to spend up to \$300.00 for annual township picnic; Lunemann; I second; all aye; motion carried.

Borden reports that the Board of Canvass met prior to meeting to certify the election results of the township election. There were a total of 17 voters. Lunemann received 17 votes for supervisor; Flaws 16 votes for treasurer.

Erik Lunemann; I make motion to adjourn; Yeager; second; all aye; motion carried.
